who dead in the battle field

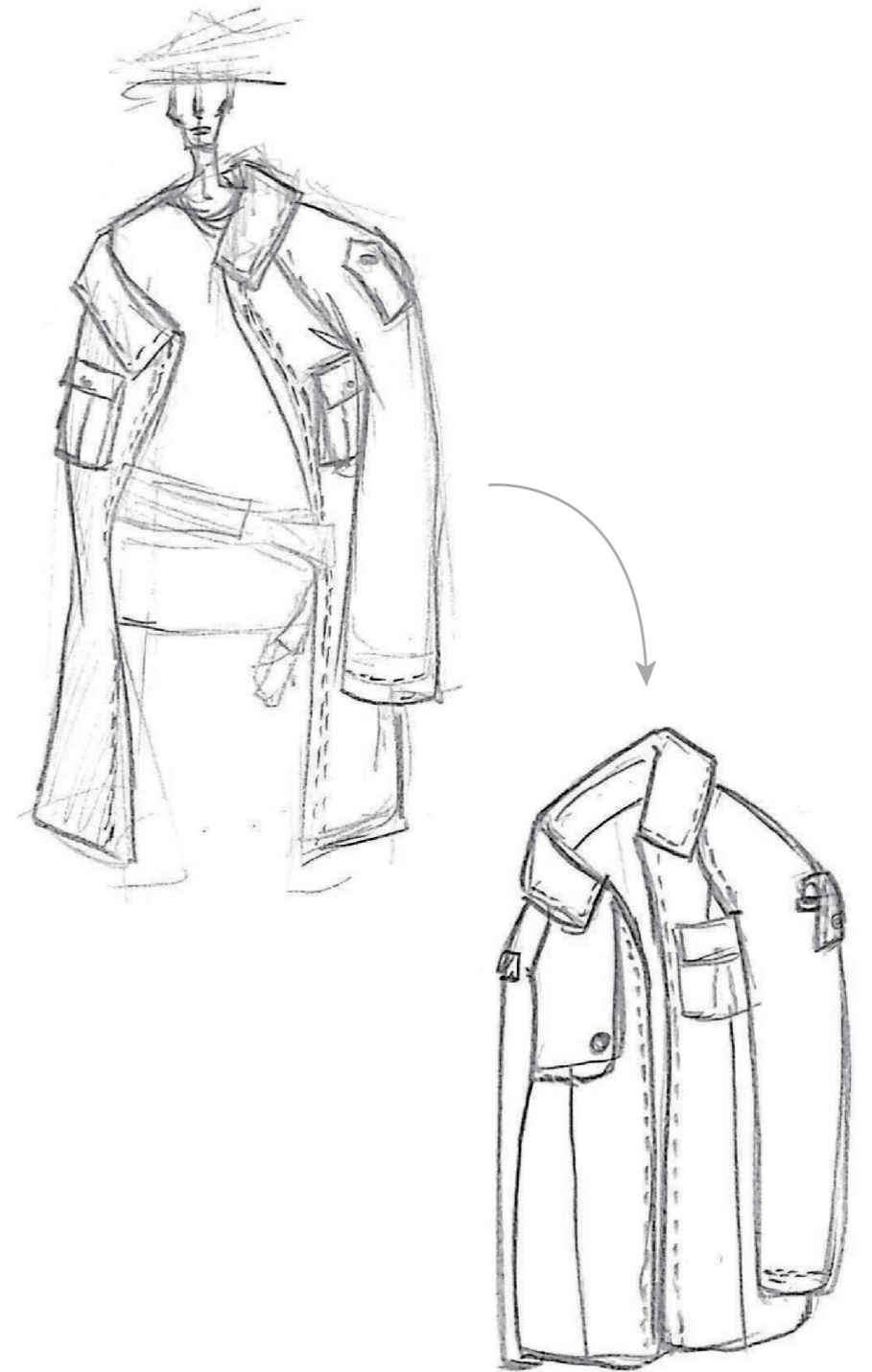


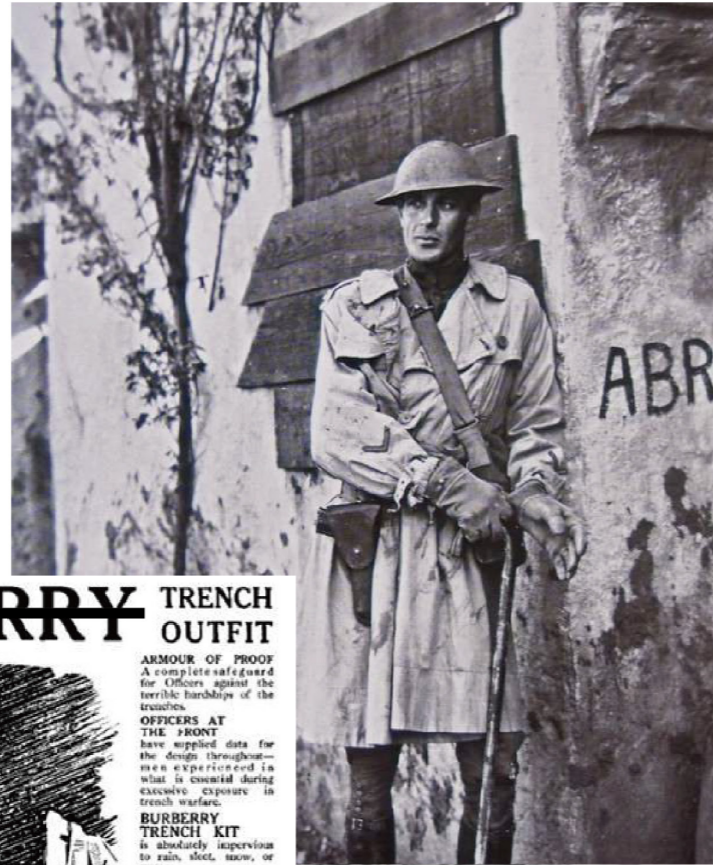
NOT MORE WAR, WE WANT PEACE

BURBERRY TRENCH WARM—contains the service of Trench coats in ONE, each of which can be worn separately. A **WEATHERPROOF** that keeps out any rain that an soldier keeps out a Camel Hair SHIRT-WAIST and a thick, double-lined OVERCOAT for the severest weather.

CAP COVER AND CAPE—a covering for head and neck, an extra protection over the shoulder, preventing any possibility of wet clothes in the rain.

GABARDINE SHORTS—worn as slippers, cover the Trench-Walk boots and wet-dripping soles of boots.

GABARDINE GLOVES, hand Warm, worn with the gauntlet inside the sleeves of the coat, and

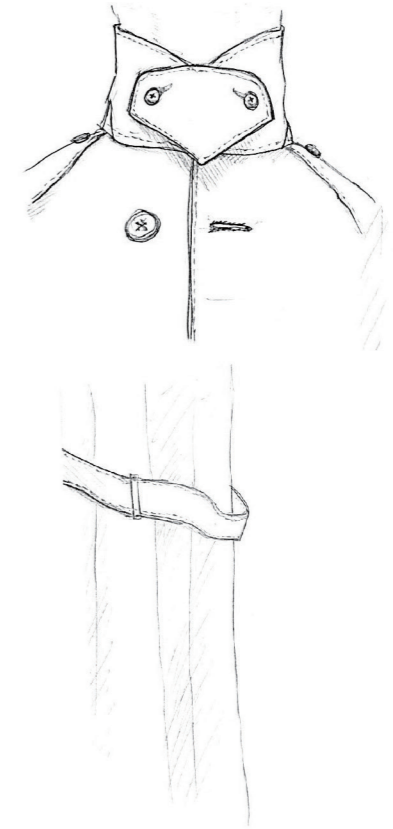
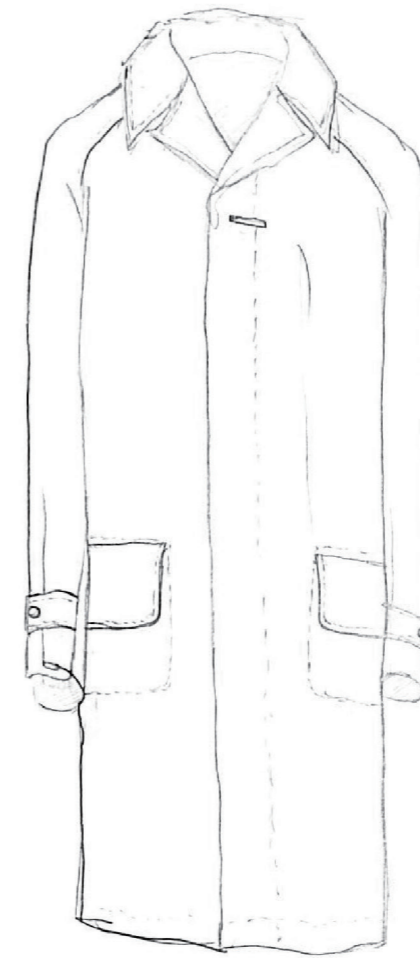
BURBERRY TRENCH BOOTS complete the trench and reproduce well for the Officer in the trenches.

reconstruction the trench coat front and back

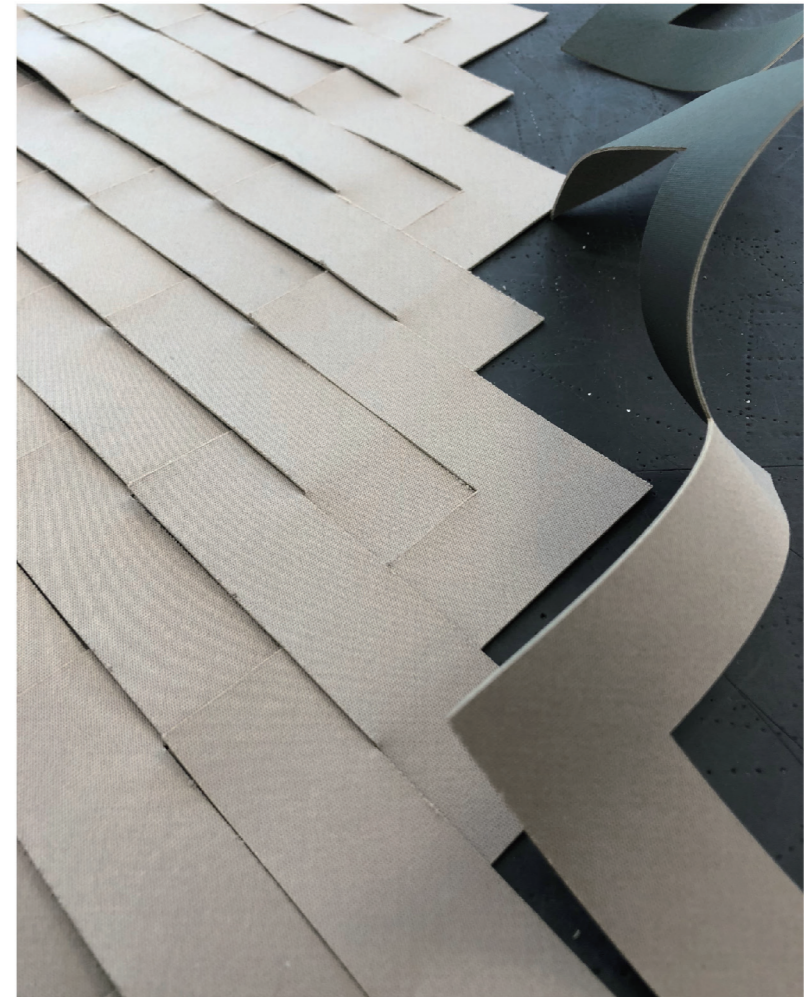


shoulder details of trench coat

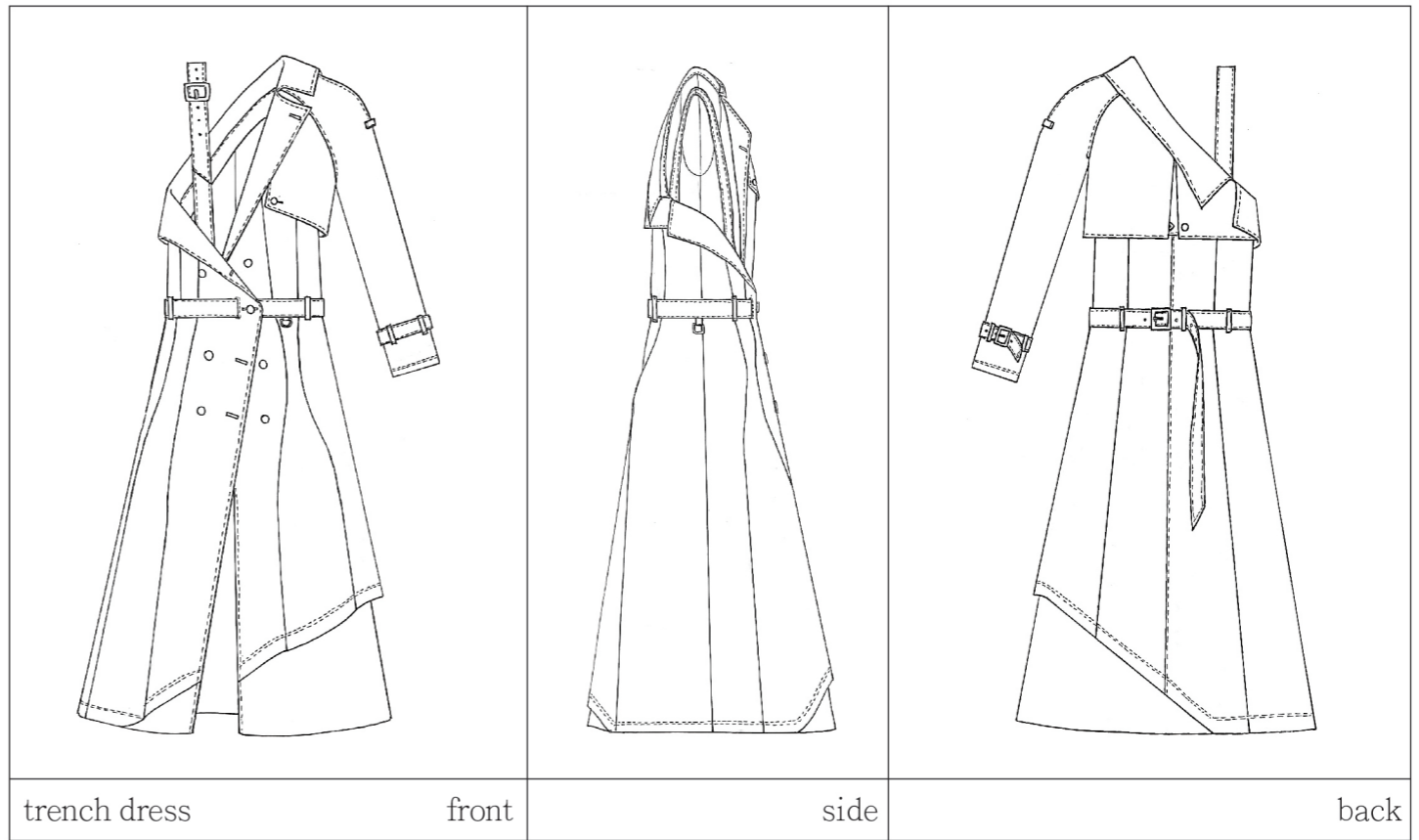
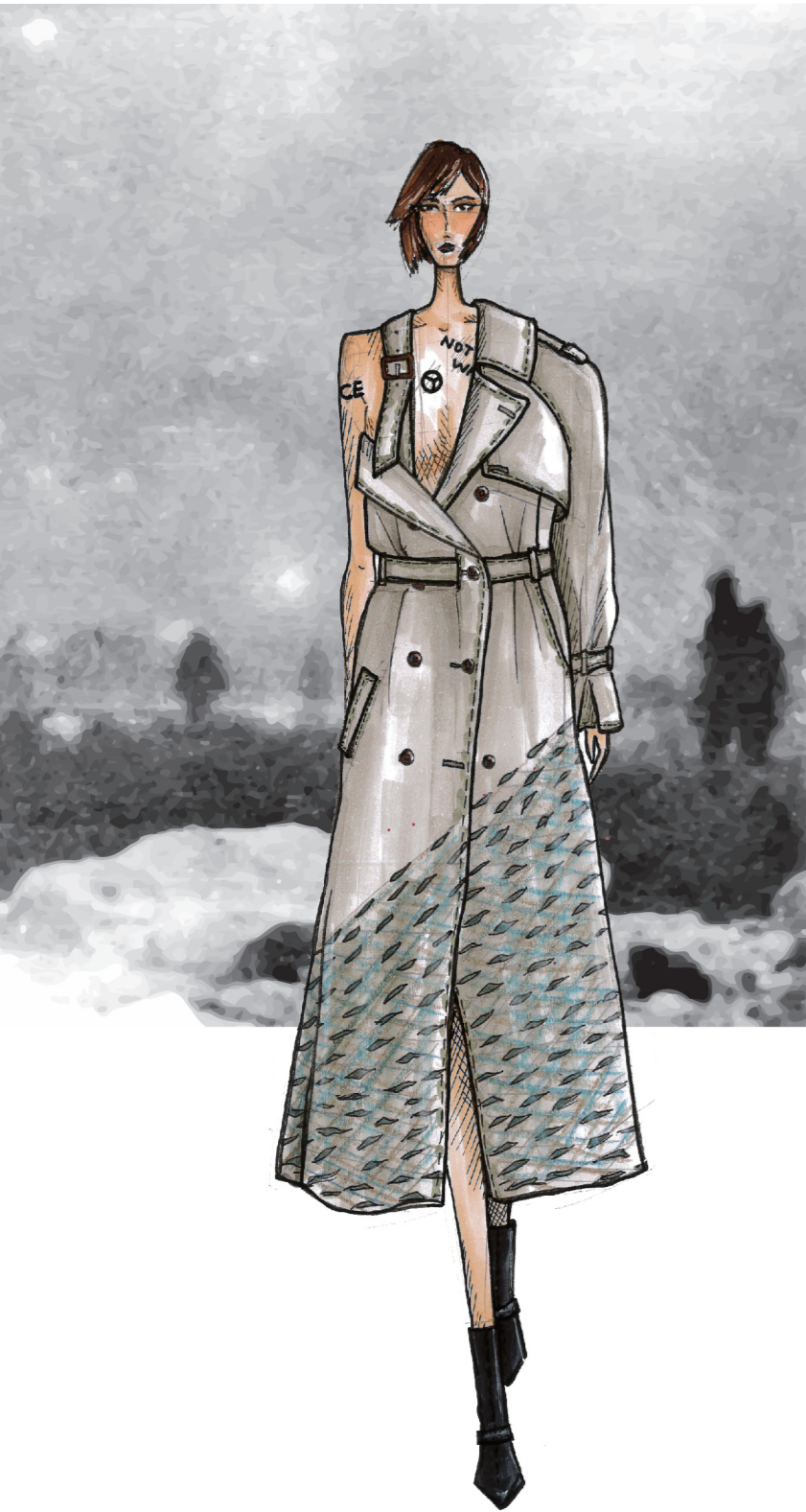
